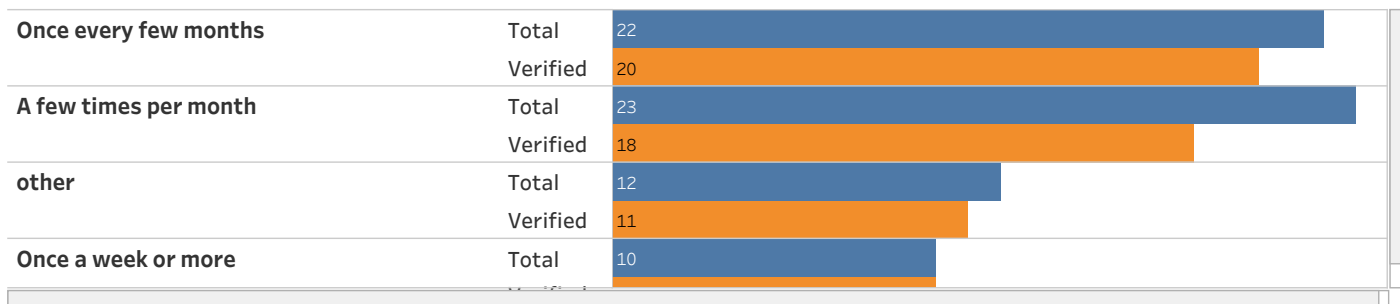


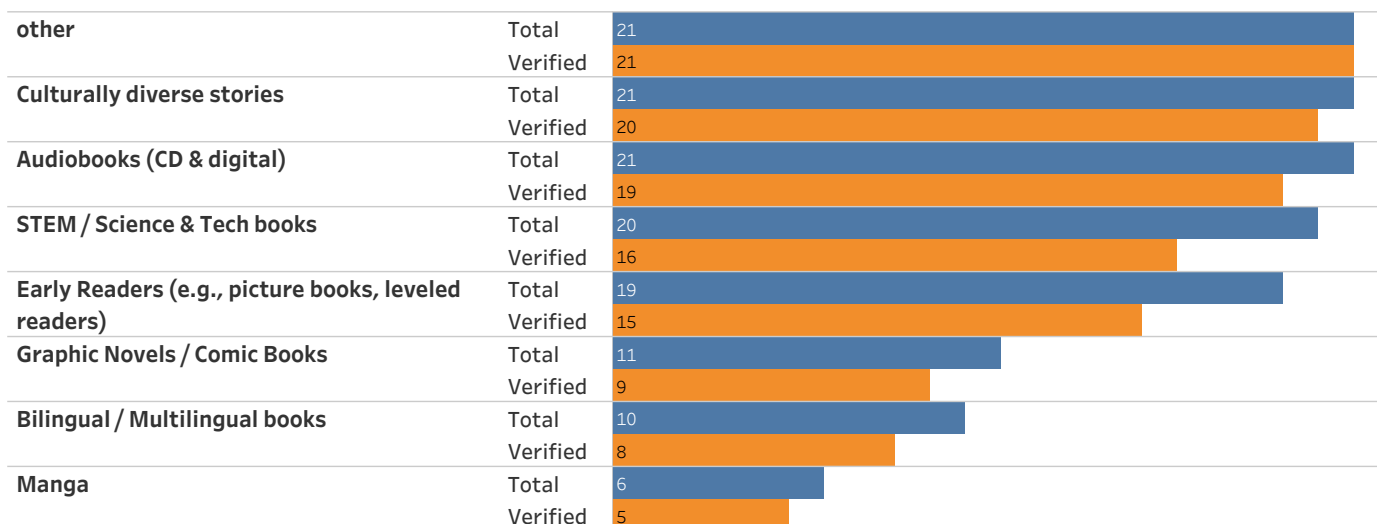

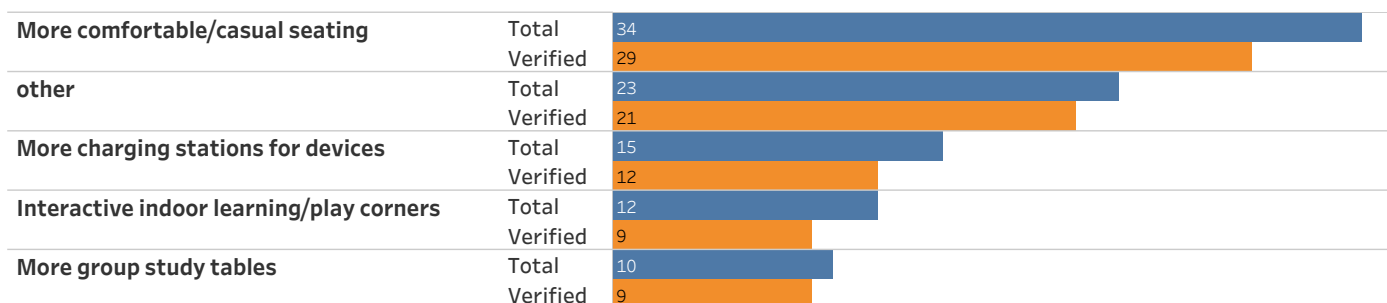
Question 1. On average, how frequently does your family visit the Cupertino Library?



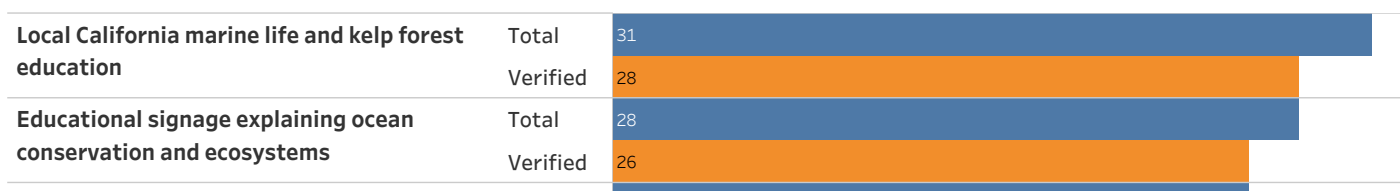
Question 2. What types of books or reading materials would you like to see more of in the Cupertino Library collection? (Select all that apply)
